Currently, of the 5310 funds that are available, there is \$356,929 from FY 2015, \$360,053 from FY 2016, and \$356,403.43 from FY 2017 for a total of \$1,073,385.43. GPATS is able to hold onto funding that goes back as far as three years. Any funding that is unused outside of the three year window is sent back to the US treasury.
